If you or one of your adult leaders has not taken the opportunity to learn the basics of providing a quality program to your youth; please join us on **Saturday, July 19<sup>th</sup> 2008** for a fun day of learning and growth. (LDS instructors will be available.)

## Boy Scouts of America Courses will include:

- New Leader Essentials** is a great introduction to the Family of Scouting programs, their aims and methods. This course is required of ALL leaders to be considered fully trained. (*You only need to complete this training **once** in your Scouting career.*)
- Cub Scout Leader Specific Training** is a comprehensive overview of the training you need to be a Tiger Cub Leader, Wolf Den Leader, Bear Den Leader, Webelos Den Leader, Cubmaster or Pack Committee.; **this class covers it all FEE:** \$5 (\$7.50 with position books)
- Boy Scout Leader Specific Training** is a comprehensive overview of the training you need to be a Boy Scout Leader and operate a successful Troop Program. [To be considered *TRAINED* you must complete, Boy Scout Leader Specific **and** IOLS (not being offered) FEE: \$10 (\$15.00 with position books)
- Varsity Scout Leader Specific Training** is for all Coaches, Asst. Coaches and other leaders involved in the Varsity Scouting program. This program is tailored to help you meet the needs of young men in the 14-15 age range but also uses many of the same leadership skills first taught in Boy Scouts. (To be considered *TRAINED* you must complete, Varsity Scout Leader Specific **and** IOLS (not being offered) FEE \$10 (/ \$15.00 with position books)
- Venturing Leader Specific Training** will guide you through Scouting's newest program. Designed to help retain our older youth's enthusiasm while still being able to continue their quest for Eagle can mean the difference in keeping these young men active. FEE: \$10 (\$15.00 with position books)
- Troop Committee Challenge** explains how Troop Committees interact and support the Troops programs. When working together the Troop Committee can help a struggling program become successful and one that the boys will love.
- Commissioner Basics** explains a Commissioners job and how they can impact a unit. **For Commissioners Only!**
- Correlation of Scouting with the Quorum, Duty to God and Mutual.** This class is not an official training of the BSA or of the LDS church, but is being offered for our LDS Scouting leaders, including Bishoprics and Young Men Presidencies, who have already completed the BSA Leader Specific Training for their respective stewardships. The class will present ideas as to how the various Scouting programs can be integrated into a Ward's Mutual program as complimentary tools rather than competing programs.

Training will take place at the Mount Vernon LDS Stake Center, 1700 Hazel St.  
Although we ask that you bring your own brown bag lunch, a beverage will be provided.
